Eligibility criteria: To be eligible candidates must:

*Be enrolled in undergraduate degree and/or approved Honours program with a recognised institution

*Open to all university students of a high academic merit

*The scholarship contract is with the research institution (university or research organisation), not the student (applicant).

*Application proposal should be developed in consultation with your research institution. Any concerns can be highlighted in the application

Expected project outputs and outcomes:

Output:

At the conclusion of a CRDC-funded research project, the students must provide a final report to the CRDC by the date specified in the contract.
